Secretary's Report – Minutes from the June meeting were published in the newsletter.

Safety Officer's Report – Members were reminded be careful at the field in the summer heat and remember to bring water.

Old Business

Ben reminded members to use judgement when flying aircraft early. No loud aircraft before 8am. This is an attempt to appearse neighbors based on a complete sent in June.

Jason provided on update on the lease. Talked with Paul Brown from the city, and he was looking for officer names. Chris (director of parks and rec), wanted to add a clause that both us and the city recognize that our field is eligible for improvement. At the last check-in meeting, this has still not been added. Jason will be regularly checking in with Paul to try to get this moved to completion. Chris previously worked with Irving RC club, so he is familiar with RC aircraft operations. Frank was

Frank proposed getting new front tires for the tractor and new tires for the brush hog. Other options were discussed, and members decided that it was time to cut the field on our own. \$870 was allocated and approved towards replacing the tires and changing the oil on the tractor.

New Business

A new member, Bill Vogeley introduced himself to the membership. He just moved back from Utah and is looking forward to flying with the club. Welcome to the club Bill!

Frank talked about his new laser cutter. He picked it up on Amazon for \$850. It has a large tray capable of cutting 36" balsa and runs off of a program called lightburn. It uses a 10 watt laser capable of cutting 1/4" plywood.

Frank and Michael discussed 3D printers. The possibility of custom designed tires were discussed, with the hub printed in a hard plastic (like PETG) and the tire printed in TPU.

Ben has nearly finished repairing his Wendel Williams Racer and is hoping to have it ready to go soon.

August 12th is national model aviation day. The membership decided to hold an event with flight demos and buddy boxes. Bob will CD the event. Advertising the event around the local neighborhood and in Hobbytown USA were discussed.


